# What's On Your Plate? Meat Glue, GMO, or Concentrate

#### Introduction

You were told it was chicken.

You were told it was safe.

You were told it was real.

But the truth is — what's on your plate today is not the food of Scripture.

It's a synthetic sorcery, born in the labs of greed and spliced by the hands of modern-day priests of Mammon.

From meat glued together like Frankenstein's creature, to genetically corrupted seeds, to concentrates boiled down until life itself is gone — our food has been desecrated.

And worst of all?

Most people never even question it.

But YHWH does.

And so should we.

Food Was Once a Covenant

In Scripture, food was never just fuel.

It was covenantal — a sacred exchange between Creator and creation.

Eating was an act of worship and obedience.

Blood was never to be eaten, for it was holy.

Seed, flesh, and harvest were to remain as He made them — pure, unmixed, undefiled.

YHWH gave us laws not to restrict us — but to protect us.

Now, imagine this:

You sit down to a meal.

The steak on your plate isn't really steak — it's scraps of meat, glued together with a chemical enzyme.

The corn beside it has had its DNA rewritten in a lab.

Most of us would be horrified to eat this kind of meal.

And yet — in churches around the world, this is exactly the kind of spiritual food being served every week.

Man-made doctrines glued together from scraps of Scripture

Salvation formulas genetically altered from their original source

Watered-down teachings from concentrate, crafted for mass consumption and shelf life

If you care what's on your dinner plate... shouldn't you care even more about what's on your spiritual one?

## Meat Glue — Manmade Doctrine Masquerading as Whole Truth

In the food world, there's a hidden ingredient called transglutaminase — better known as meat glue.

It's used to bind together scraps of meat — leftovers, trimmings, and pieces that no one would buy on their own — and it fuses them into something that looks like a whole steak.

But it's not.

It's an illusion.

It was stitched together in secret, held by an invisible binder, then served up to people who never suspect the truth.

And this is exactly what's happened in the church.

Modern Christian doctrine is not one cohesive message from YHWH — it's a patchwork quilt of cherry-picked verses, borrowed traditions, and man-made theology, held together by emotional glue and centuries of repetition.

It looks whole.

It tastes acceptable.

But it's not what YHWH gave.

#### Consider the ingredients:

- A verse from Paul's letter here...
- A line from a church creed there...
- A sprinkle of Roman philosophy...
- A handful of mistranslated Hebrew...

And out comes a steak called "The Trinity."
Another one called "Faith Alone."
A third called "The Sinner's Prayer."
A fourth labeled "The Rapture."

But none of these were ever spoken by YHWH. Not at Sinai. Not in the Prophets. Not in the Torah. They were glued together by men — and served to a hungry people too trusting to question the texture.

You were told it was truth — but it was leftovers.

You were told it was holy — but it was human.

You were told it was salvation — but it was sorcery, crafted in theological kitchens with no fire from Heaven.

If the food is fake, what happens to those who eat it? If the doctrine is manmade, what kind of disciples is it producing?

Don't be deceived by the appearance of "whole." YHWH's truth doesn't need glue. It was whole from the beginning.

## **GMOs** — Doctrines Genetically Altered by Church Fathers

What is a GMO?

A Genetically Modified Organism — a man-made mutation.

It begins with something pure... natural... whole.

But then men in white coats crack it open, tamper with its DNA, and stitch in something foreign — a piece of bacteria, an animal gene, a pesticide sequence — all to make it more convenient, more profitable, or more resistant to the environment.

On the outside, it still looks like food.

But inside?

It's been rewritten — no longer what the Creator designed.

And the Church has done the same.

They took the pure Seed of Torah. The nourishing grain of obedience. The bloodline of the Messiah. And they cracked it open.

They took the pure Seed of Torah.
The nourishing grain of obedience.
The Covenant that was meant to guide.
The promises made to the Fathers.
And they cracked it open.

They didn't like what it said. It was too Jewish. Too rigid. Too demanding. So, they tampered with the DNA.

It grows large, but it doesn't grow roots.

It is spiritually sterile — and like all GMOs, it cannot reproduce the life it pretends to contain.

The original essence is gone.

What's left is a shell of what once grew on the tree — dressed up in flavor and poured into a shiny carton labeled "100% Truth."

And this is exactly what modern Christianity serves in pulpits around the world.

They don't give the Word in its raw, convicting form.

They give motivational sermons with catchy titles.

They pour out emotional appeals with music swells and dim lights.

They hand out mass-manufactured belief made for shelf life — not for transformation.

There's no depth.

No substance.

No real nourishment.

Just sugar, acid, and artificial flavor.

You've heard the slogans:

- "Just believe."
- "Come as you are."
- "You're already forgiven."
- "God wants you to prosper."
- "Grace covers everything."

But none of this is the full Word of YHWH.

It's from concentrate — boiled down to palatability, repackaged for mass appeal, and distributed in every flavor to suit the crowd.

YHWH gave us Living Water. They've turned it into Kool-Aid.

## **Defilement in Disguise**

Today's church doctrines come dressed in beautiful labels: "Grace," "Freedom," "Spirit-filled," "Anointed."
But what's under the label often bears no resemblance to the original Truth.

Like a processed package at the grocery store, it says "All Natural" — But read the fine print: it's full of man-made ingredients.

And in the end, deception defiles.

Bread gained by deceit is sweet to a man, but afterward his mouth will be filled with gravel. (Proverbs 20:17)

Many swallowing gravel — thinking it's manna. They smile at the taste, never realizing they're chewing lies.

## What Torah Teaches About the Seed, the Flesh, and the Table

The Torah was never a list of cold restrictions.

It is/was a blueprint for life — a divine pattern to preserve the Seed, the Flesh, and the Table.

Every truth was to reproduce after its kind — never mixed, never altered.

Every teaching was to remain whole

— not spliced, sweetened, or stripped.

Every offering on YHWH's altar had to be pure, whole, and unblemished.

But the Church has tampered with the Seed:

- They've mixed covenants, confused law and grace.
- They've grafted in Roman tradition and Greek philosophy.
- They've served up a theological hybrid one YHWH never authorized.

Now they offer a meal that YHWH never prepared.

One that He never blessed.

One that He never asked to be eaten.

## **Living Set-Apart in a Polluted World**

Don't just accept the label — read the ingredients.

Just because it says "Grace-filled" doesn't mean it's from YHWH.

Don't just trust the pulpit — test it against the Torah.

The Word was written in stone, not on sermon slides.

Don't follow the crowd — follow the cloud and the fire.

The path was never meant to be popular — just holy (Set-Apart).

YHWH has always called His people to be *qadosh* — set apart.

Different in their worship.

Different in their walk.

Different in what they eat — physically and spiritually.

"I have set before you life and death, blessing and curse."

"Choose life..." (Deuteronomy 30:19)

And let's be clear:

You can't trust Pharaoh to feed you manna.

He'll give you bricks without straw and call it grace.

You must rise early — before the sun, before the system — and gather the Bread of Heaven for yourself.

Not weekly. Not when it's convenient.

Daily.

By the Word.

## Conclusion: The Altar Has Been Replaced by a Microphone

He gave us a Covenant meal — not a buffet of beliefs.

He gave us Instructions (Torah) — *not catchy choruses*.

He gave us fire from Heaven — not fog machines and emotion.

The altar is gone...

and in its place stands a preacher with a wireless mic and a sermon that wouldn't dare mention sin.

Babylon has cooked your theology.

She's stirred in her own spices — Greek thought, Roman holidays, pagan customs, and feel-good fables.

And she's served it to the nations, piping hot, with a side of smooth sayings and a syrupy smile.

But now you know.

So, what will you do?

Will you keep feasting at her table?

Or will you push the plate away — and return to the Ancient Table of YHWH?

Come back to what is whole.

Come back to what is real.

Come back to the Covenant meal.

Truth is not processed.

It is planted.

And it grows where obedience waters the ground.

## **♦ Questions to Ponder ♦**

If you wouldn't eat meat scraps glued together in a lab... why are you accepting glued-together doctrines from the pulpit?

→ Truth is not a mix of fragments. YHWH's Word is whole. Man has stitched together verses to support doctrines YHWH never spoke.

If you care about genetically modified food... shouldn't you be even more concerned about genetically modified faith?

→ The Church has altered the DNA of truth — mixing covenants, rebranding grace, and rewriting obedience. YHWH warned us not to mix kinds — and that includes spiritual seed.

Would you willingly drink orange juice that was boiled down, rehydrated, and filled with sugar and dyes?

Then why drink a gospel "from concentrate" — made for shelf life instead of sanctification?

 $\rightarrow$  The modern message is sweet but empty. It fills pews, not hearts. It soothes minds but never calls for change.

## Are you letting emotion and packaging decide what you believe? Or are you testing every teaching against the Torah?

→ Labels lie. Music moves. Crowds follow. But truth must be tested — not tasted. The Torah is the ingredient list. Check it.

#### Why does the modern church look nothing like the people YHWH called holy?

→ Because they've left the table of YHWH and eaten at the table of Rome. They've adopted new days, new doctrines, and new gods — all dressed in old names.

## If YHWH gave us manna from heaven... why are you still accepting bread from Pharaoh?

→ Manna had to be gathered daily, by faith, in obedience. Pharaoh offers convenience, control, and compromise. You can't eat both.

#### Are you spiritually nourished — or just emotionally full?

→ Real bread sustains, convicts, and transforms. If the messages you're hearing never pierce you, you're not being fed — you're being fattened for slaughter.

#### Would YHWH recognize the doctrines you're clinging to as His?

→ If it wasn't spoken at Sinai, confirmed in Torah, or upheld by the Prophets — it isn't His. No matter how long it's been preached.

## Are you living a set-apart life, or just eating what everyone else eats?

→ Being *qadosh* means standing apart, obeying the Torah — even at the table. Most people are spiritually sick because they're eating the world's food and calling it holy.

#### What table will you eat from tomorrow?

→ The altar of convenience and emotion? Or the table of truth and obedience? One fills the flesh. The other feeds the soul.

Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; Who put darkness for light and light for darkness; Who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (Isaiah 5:20)
