

- Because entire doctrines rest on English words that do not exist in the Hebrew text. People are building beliefs on vocabulary the prophets never used.
- Because Hebrew words carry meaning that English cannot hold. Hebrew is concrete and functional; English is abstract and philosophical. That difference changes everything.
- Because returning to Hebrew exposes what was added later. Creeds, councils, and traditions often contradict the original text.
- Because Hebrew restores the original context — the worldview, the covenant, the culture, and the function embedded in the language.
- Because Hebrew reveals patterns and structures that translations flatten: root families, parallelism, word-pictures, covenant logic.
- Because Hebrew shows what God actually said, not what later systems claim He said.
- Because Hebrew removes theological spin. When you return to the original words, the text speaks for itself.
- Because the Ancient Path is written in Hebrew. If the path is ancient, the language must be ancient too.
- Hebrew is the language through which the Creator revealed His Instructions. Returning to it restores clarity, meaning, and truth.
